

Harness the wind

Make a pinwheel and enjoy watching
the power of the wind.





You will need:

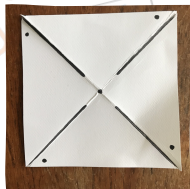
- a straight stick (a chopstick or the handle of a long wooden spoon would do)
- scissors
- pencil or marker
- some bendy wire or a twist tie from a sandwich bag
- a sheet of paper
- two beads



Fold one top corner of your paper over to one of the long sides to make a square. Using the pencil or marker, draw a line and cut away the excess paper.



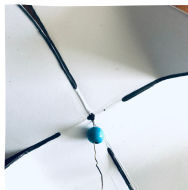
Fold the other top corner diagonally to the other corner. Draw along the folds, stopping about an inch away from the centre of the paper. Cut along these lines.



(Ask an adult to) poke holes in the right corner of the triangles and in the middle of the paper.



Twist a piece of wire around your straight stick then thread it through the hole in the middle of the paper.



Thread one of the beads on to this. Thread the holey corners of your triangles onto the wire.



Finish by threading another bead and twisting the wire around it to secure.
